Selecting a look thats right for you.

The visual height of a panel is an important consideration when choosing a metal roofing system. Rib panels give a 'softer' continuous look, while profiled panels generally have a raised step pattern that commands your attention. Both the rib and profile panels are connected to the roof using colour matched exposed fasteners (screws). Standing Seam roofs use concealed fasteners meaning all you will ever see is clean distinctive vertical lines that run the entire length of the roof (no visible screws). Every Steel Tile metal roofing system have matching accessories and trims to complete the look.

All metals are NOT the same.

Don't be fooled by companies trying to pass off tin or aluminum panels as being just as strong and durable as a roll-formed steel panel roof. Steel Tile uses only the highest grade 26 or 29 gauge G-90 Galvanized steel manufactured to meet strict standards and specifications.


Gauge is the measurement of sheet metal thickness. The lower the gauge number, the thicker the material. Steel Tile provides panels in three thicknesses. 29, 26 and special order 24 gauge steel. Our most popular panel the Summit, capitalizes on using 29 gauge steel because of the distinctive rib pattern that makes it one of the stiffest and strongest load bearing panels in the industry. Other rib and profile panels are manufactured with 26 gauge thicker metal and offer the same outstanding structural performance and superior durability. Standing seam metal roofs are produced from 26 gauge steel and can be special ordered using 24 gauge steel.

Colour choice.

Steel Tile panels, including accessories, trims and flashings, are available in 14 standard colours and one special wall finish to achieve your design vision. Three Crinkle colours are available in 26 gauge steel, the Crinkle black panel can also be ordered in 29 gauge. The advanced Weather XL technology is formulated with a proprietary durable resin which provides superior resistance to chalking and fading, especially in extreme heat and UV exposure locations. Weather XL paints exceptional coating hardness, flex ratio and abrasion resistance out-performs

other finishes in the harshest of climates. Weather XL paint provides a new level of long term exterior performance for building product applications, backed by the best warranty in the business.

Some Metal Roofing Myths

"Meat roofs are noisy, when it rains"

This is one of the most common misconceptions of residential metal roofing. This myth was born from the use of metal on large open beamed old barns, garden sheds and storage buildings. The main differences between an open barn and a residential roof is updated building standards, insulation, a solid plywood base and approved underlayments. These elements combined dampen any noise, resulting in a roof that is just as quiet as any other roofing material.

"Metal roofs rust easily."

Metal roofs and coatings have come a long way. Steel Tile features advanced Weather XL technology that is formulated with a proprietary durable resin which provides superior resistance especially in extreme heat and UV exposure locations. Weather XL protective paints have undergone real-world weathering tests to ensure your metal roof will remain impervious to corrosion for decades to come.

"Metal roofs are prone to lighting strikes."

Lightening strikes may occur at the highest point of any area, regardless of material. Metal roofs have the same chance of being struck as a regular asphalt shingled roof in the same location.

"You can't stand or walk on a metal roof."

Metal roofing is very durable. You can walk or safely stand between the ribs on a metal roof without causing damage to the panel. The plywood deck or strapping under the metal panels provide ample support to hold a person. Always use safety precautions and a secured harness when on a roof.

"Metal roofs are too heavy for a structure."

A fully installed metal roof is generally 1/3 the weight of an asphalt roof and surprisingly 75% lighter than fiber cement shakes and slate.

"Metal roofs get hot."

Under sunlight all roofs gets hot. However, Weather XL cool roof ceramic pigments reflect heat up and away from buildings. Metal also releases solar heat quicker than asphalt shingles reducing the heat load on a home. Studies show that reflective metal roofs reduce the homes cooling efficiency during hot summer months by up to 35%, saving energy and money.

Optimal performance.

"How long will any roof last?" The lifespan of any roof is dependent on several factors including, materials, location, weather conditions and the contractor. Cost can sometimes be a deciding factor when choosing between a metal roof and other less durable roofing materials. It's important to consider individual home ownership goals before purchasing.

Would you buy a house if the exterior walls needed to be replaced every 10-15 years? Not likely. Yet millions of homeowners annually purchase homes with asphalt shingle roofs that may only last 15 years at best. A typical asphalt roof will last between 8 and 15 years with a pro-rated limited warranty. A metal roof on the other hand that can withstand high winds and heavy snow loads, will not split, crack, burn or blister is backed by a 40-year transferable warranty. Your roof could last upwards of 70 years according to the Roofers Union of Canada, when properly installed and maintained.







Make it pitch perfect.

Designed to accommodate practically any roofing gradient. Each roofing panel is ideal for several applications ranging from low to steep sloping roofs and suitable down to a specific minimum roof pitch or slope. Common residential roofs are 4/12, 6/12, and 8/12 gable, hip and mono-pitched roofs. Contact our sales team for a no obligation estimate.

Light weight, year round installation.

Metal roofing panels weigh less than half the weight of traditional shingles per sq. ft. Metal roofs can be installed with 1"x4" strapping over existing asphalt shingles. This procedure eliminates the need for costly disposal and reduces the amount of material that is sent to our already overburdened landfill sites. No need to wait for summer to install a roof, metal roofs are regularly installed all year round. The old shingles can act as a sound barrier and provide an extra layer of insulation against snow and the sun's rays.



The full-length panel advantage.

Steel Tile manufactures full-length custom-cut panels up to 28 feet in length. There are several advantages to using a Steel Tile metal roofing system, including minimal on-site preparation, faster installation per square foot, resulting in time and cost savings. Fewer horizontal seams reduce the possibility of leaks unlike smaller multi-panelled clip-on roofing systems. Full-length panels can be applied directly onto a plywood base for newer construction or routinely placed over top of existing shingles. This process is common and will not overload the roof structure. Strapping will allow adequate venting between layers. Our panels are rigorously tested and meet Miami-Dade and Florida Building Code requirements - the toughest hurricane approval bodies in the world.



LASTING VALUE

The first thing any potential home buyer will notice when purchasing a home is the roof. Standing seams are engaged in one of three ways; "Snap Lock", "Nail Strip" or "Mechanical Lock" all providing superior benefits. By folding and crimping the edges between the panels, standing seam keeps water and debris out. This concealed fastening method offers a higher level of protection and a more attractive appearance than any other metal roofing application. The ability to handle thermal movement allows the panels to slightly move when it gets hot or cold without compromising the roofs structure, making the roof last longer and stay strong year after year.






Sliding snow around or above exterior doors, windows and walkways is a safety concern. If neglected, the effects of sliding snow from metal roofs can be a potential hazard. Steel Tile offers two effective durable solutions to make steel roofing safer and more suitable for busy locations and also help to save eavestroughing from being torn off or damaged.

Snow Stops are recommended for heavy snow load locations and steep roofs. Snow Stop is secured directly over the metal roofing panels and is designed to stop the downward movement of snow until it melts or falls off the roof in small amounts that will not cause any damage. Available in ten foot lengths or installers can cut Snow Stop into smaller pieces to fit specific areas. Colour matching Snow Stops easily blend into any metal roofing system facade.

SnowLok. SnowLok holds snow and ice on the roof longer and allows it to melt gradually. SnowLoks may be small but they provide high tech snow slide protection and are made from durable Lexan™. Strong and flexible, SnowLok will help hold the snow and ice under heavy snow-load conditions. In addition, SnowLok is a clear product that simply attaches to the roof with two matching screws, making it almost invisible on any coloured roof.








